Description

Step aboard Bed of Roses, a beautifully maintained 45ft traditional stern narrowboat that blends timeless charm with thoughtful modern upgrades. Built by respected boatbuilder John White in 1993, she is perfectly sized for solo cruising, couples, or small families, offering a homely and practical layout that makes her ideal for both liveaboard living and life on the move.

Powered by a reliable Beta Marine 35 engine and featuring a fully refurbished PRM gearbox (2024), Bed of Roses has been carefully looked after, with a solid maintenance record to give you confidence on the water. She was blacked in May 2025 and underwent a full survey at the same time, giving peace of mind to any prospective owner. A valid Boat Safety Certificate runs until October 2027, ensuring compliance and safety for years to come.

Inside, the boat is arranged in a popular stern-to-bow layout: a cosy master bedroom leads to a stylishly renovated bathroom, followed by a practical and well-equipped galley, and finally a bright and inviting lounge space at the bow. Each area has been carefully designed to maximise comfort, storage, and functionality, making life on board easy and enjoyable.

In the master bedroom, you'll find a fixed double bed with generous drawers beneath for storage, alongside an enclosed wardrobe and additional shelving — offering everything you need for day-to-day living without compromise.

The bathroom, fully refurbished in 2022, has a contemporary feel with a stone sink set in a vanity unit, a modern shower cubicle, and a compost toilet, which can easily be swapped out for a cassette system if preferred. Thoughtful touches like extra storage and neutral finishes give it a light and spacious feel.

The galley is equipped with a full-size cooker and four-ring hob, a 12V fridge/freezer, and wooden worktops that give it a warm, rustic feel. Ample under-counter cupboards and drawers offer practical storage solutions for cookware and provisions, while the open-plan flow into the lounge enhances the feeling of space.

The lounge area is perfect for relaxing or working from the water. A futon sofa converts to a single guest bed, while a custom-built storage unit offers integrated cupboards and a built-in desk positioned under the window — a unique feature for remote workers or hobbyists. A multi-fuel stove adds both charm and warmth, making this space cosy and inviting all year round.

With power supplied via shore power, an alternator, and a Victron solar setup feeding LifePo4 lithium-ion batteries, Bed of Roses is designed for energy efficiency and off-grid living. A 400L water tank and 240L fuel tank ensure extended cruising capability without constant stops.

Finishing touches like custom-made bow doors add a sense of individuality and craftsmanship, completing this boat's warm and characterful aesthetic.

Whether you're seeking your first liveaboard or a compact cruiser with heart, Bed of Roses offers a rare opportunity to own a ready-to-go narrowboat that delivers comfort, character, and quality in equal measure.
