The master bedroom offers a tranquil space to rest, featuring a double fixed bed with underbed storage to keep bedding and personal items neatly tucked away. Porthole windows provide natural light while maintaining privacy, and an overhead shelf with reading lights ensures you can unwind with a book before sleep. A wall-mounted mirror completes the space, adding both functionality and a sense of openness.

The compact yet practical bathroom is fitted with a Thetford cassette toilet, a corner sink, and a shower with mixer taps. A vanity mirror and shelving offer convenient storage for toiletries and everyday essentials, making this space both efficient and easy to maintain.

The galley is thoughtfully laid out, combining functionality with classic narrowboat charm. It features a stainless steel sink with a modern mixer tap, a Stateman oven and grill with a four-burner gas hob, and a Shoreline fridge to keep provisions fresh. Above and below the worktops, you'll find plenty of wall shelving, a storage cupboard, and a dresser unit, offering ample space for cookware and dry goods. A built-in wine rack adds a touch of elegance to this well-equipped kitchen space. A Morco water heater provides hot water throughout the boat.

Relax and unwind in the inviting saloon, where a comfortable L-shaped seating area doubles as a dining and social space. The Enox TV is perfectly positioned for evening entertainment, while storage cupboards and a wall-mounted corner unit provide additional space for personal belongings. The rich wooden flooring adds warmth underfoot, and a Houdini hatch above floods the area with natural light and ventilation. For those cooler nights, the solid fuel stove keeps the boat cosy, creating a snug and homely atmosphere.
