Moving forward, the split galley is intelligently arranged for efficiency and comfort. It includes wood worktops, a 4-ring gas hob, oven/grill, sink and drainer, fridge/freezer, tiled splashback, and ample cupboard storage.

At the bow, the boat opens into a bright and inviting forward saloon. Here you'll find a Morso Squirrel stove, wall-mounted TV, and a futon sofa—perfect for relaxing or entertaining.

Ellie's Marbles features a warm, homely interior with a smart blend of wood-faced and painted panels, enhanced by attractive hardwood framing and trim. Flooring consists of wood-effect laminate throughout the living areas and wipe-clean vinyl in the bathroom for easy maintenance.

Powered by a well-maintained Beta Marine 38hp, 4-cylinder engine paired with a PRM 150D2 gearbox, this boat offers smooth handling and dependable cruising. The hull is in sound condition, making her ready for adventure.
