Every inch has been thoughtfully designed, combining functionality with comfort and charm.

The galley is bright, spacious, and fully equipped for life on the water. It features a Shoreline fridge, 4-burner gas hob, oven and grill, and a General Ecology water filter for pure, fresh water on demand. Clever storage solutions include three wall-mounted cupboards, a run of four base units, and additional space beneath the sink – ensuring everything has its place. Two side hatches and a Houdini hatch flood the space with natural light and fresh air, making cooking and meal prep a pleasure.

Step into the inviting lounge, where comfort and character meet. Two plush Captain's chairs and matching footstools create a cosy seating area, centred around a Morso multi-fuel stove – perfect for those cooler evenings. Beautiful Karndean flooring runs throughout, complementing the boat's warm tones. A fixed cabinet with shelving, a three-door cupboard, and a built-in unit under the TV provide generous storage, while integrated speakers add to the relaxed and welcoming atmosphere.

Cleverly designed for both dining and sleeping, the raised Pullman dinette comfortably seats four and quickly converts into a double bed. The seating includes useful under-seat storage, ideal for bedding and cruising essentials, and there's even a lockable safe for keeping valuables secure while you're out exploring.

This practical space houses a Bosch Varioperfect 8kg A+++ washing machine, ideal for onboard laundry, and includes three well-sized storage cupboards. Whether you're living aboard or enjoying extended travels, this feature adds exceptional convenience and functionality.

The master bedroom offers a peaceful retreat with a fixed double bed set atop four deep drawers, providing ample storage without compromising space.
