The galley is a warm and welcoming space, combining practicality with traditional charm. Rich wooden worktops offer plenty of preparation space, complemented by a stainless steel sink and drainer for easy cleanup. A Shoreline fridge keeps your essentials cool, while the Spinflo Caprice oven and grill with a 4-burner hob allow for home-cooked meals even while cruising. Storage cupboards above and below provide ample space for kitchenware and provisions. A starboard-side hatch brings in natural light and fresh air—ideal for ventilation and enjoying waterside views while cooking.

Moving forward into the saloon, you're greeted by a beautifully crafted living space designed for relaxation and comfort.
